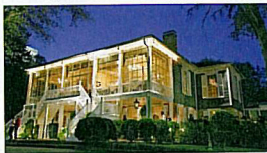
Restaurant wedding receptions

SEATED CAPACITY: 150 (entire restaurant), 50 (outdoor patio), 35 (upstairs room)
PRICE: From \$30 per person, includes two-course meal without alcohol
